




ROADHOUSE STORYTELLERS®

David Joe Miller (<http://www.davidjoemiller.com>) began his storytelling career in 1989 on the staff of the National Association for the Preservation and Perpetuation of Storytelling (NAPPS) in Jonesborough, TN. He later became the staff storyteller for the National Storytelling Association in Jonesborough and created the Jonesborough Storytellers Guild in 1994. He has told to audiences at Disney, The Smithsonian, Library of Congress, World Bank, NC Nature Conservancy and to Vice President Al Gore and his family.



Jessica Wills (<https://www.facebook.com/jess.willis.79>) is a SC homegrown spoken word artist with a big mouth and bigger imagination. Lighting up the stage with her own brand of magic she shares anything from smashing classics, to personal stories, to tales so tall she's yanked the rug out from under your feet before you realize you're off the ground.
